READ ALL DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING PROJECT

APPLICATION

NOTE Spot test on a hidden area first.

1. Apply directly to surface to be cleaned.

2. Allow product to penetrate briefly.

3. Wipe off with a clean cloth or towel.

For more difficult jobs apply a generous amount of cleaner and allow to stand for a few minutes before wiping.

For extremely tough jobs, such as the removal of old, dried latex paint, scrub with a brush or scouring pad and wash off with a wet rag.

Do not use on varnished surfaces or leather. When used in a food processing facility, rinse with potable water after use.

Do not mix this product with any other chemicals.

PRODUCT APPLICATION (cont.)

PRESSURE WASHER APPLICATION

Contains anti-corrosive agents to safeguard pressure washer parts (bleach can erode O-rings). Please be aware that water pressure alone may remove paint or highlight existing discoloration caused by sun exposure.

Rinse surrounding plants with water before and after application. Wet the surface to be cleaned prior to applying the product. Place detergent application siphon tube and screen filter directly into container. Open the meter valve (if applicable) for maximum product flow. For reservoir machines, pour product (full strength) into pressure washer. Spray at low pressure onto a wet surface. On vertical surfaces, always spray from the top down. Allow product to remain on the surface for 3 to 5 minutes to penetrate. Do not allow product to dry on surface. Remove siphon tube from solution and rinse surface with high-pressure spray thoroughly. Flush siphon tube with clean water prior to storage.

HVAC COIL CLEANING

Rust-Oleum Professional Cleaner Degreaser's blend of special surfactants and alkaline cleaners make it effective for removing dust, grease, oil, and other dirt on most HVAC coils, especially condenser and evaporator coils. Turn off power to unit prior to cleaning. When using the Rust-Oleum Professional Cleaner Degreaser aerosol foam, spray directly on coils to be cleaned. Concentrate formulas should be diluted at a 1:3 ratio (1 part Rust-Oleum Professional Cleaner Degreaser to 3 parts water), and the use of a trigger sprayer, pump sprayer or other pressurized applicator is recommended to ensure proper foaming action. Avoid spraying Cleaner Degreaser on to electrical wires. Rust-Oleum Professional Cleaner Degreaser is self-rinsing on condensate producing coils; otherwise rinse clean with water or wipe clean with a damp cloth. Return power to unit once the process is complete.

CARPET CLEANING AND STAIN REMOVAL

Rust-Oleum Professional Cleaners Cleaner Degreaser is safe for all carpet types, including synthetic as well as stain resistant carpets. Test in an inconspicuous area first. The concentrated formula will clean six 9' x 12' (2.5m x 4.0m) carpets. Coverage may vary depending on type and condition of carpet. Vacuum the carpet thoroughly. Pre-treat any stubborn spots or stains by using the undiluted concentrate as a stain remover prior to cleaning carpet. Add concentrate to the receiving/waste tank of the machine to reduce buildup. Add 4 oz. of concentrate for each gallon of water in the dispensing/fill tank. For heavy traffic areas or heavily soiled carpets, add 6 oz. of concentrate for each gallon of water. Use hot (not boiling) or cold water according to the carpet manufacturer's cleaning directions. Read machine instructions carefully. Do not overfill.
